

Home Learning in Science:

Homework in Science is set in accordance with the Schools Home Learning policy:

At KS3

Students receive a mixture of homework including either/or;

1. Weekly homework designed to consolidate learning and immediate progress in current areas being studied.
2. Extended Learning tasks; designed to take longer to complete and to focus on building engagement, enjoyment and independency in the students home learning. (Example home experiment/ Case studies).

The teacher can choose to set either type of homework to best suit the needs of his/her class at that time.

At KS4

Students studying **Triple** science will be given weekly homework designed to deepen their understanding in the topic and/or to further consolidate learning. Students will also be given homework which focus on the 6 mark questions to help them gain as much experience and practice with this new style questioning in GCSE Sciences.

Students who study the **Additional Applied & Core Sciences** will receive a home learning booklet which focuses on exam style questions and consolidation of classroom learning.

Weekly homework can be set by the teacher as and when the teacher deems necessary.

All Homework will be marked according to the Departments Marking policy giving valuable feedback to pupils.
