Homework Policy

Key Stage Three

Students will be set a weekly homework to consolidate the learning that has taken place in class that week. The homework will be at the class teacher's discretion.

Key Stage Four

Students will be set two pieces of homework per week. One will be an exam style question, this will consolidate the learning that has taken place that week and later on in the year will form part of revision for the exam. The second homework will be to practice key vocabulary, which will be tested in class weekly.

Failure to complete homework

If students fail to complete homework they will be issued a detention by their class teacher. If a student fails to attend this detention they will be referred to the Head of Department. The Head of Department will issue a second detention and will contact parents, either through the student's planner or a phone call home. Failure to attend the Head of Department detention will result in referral to the student's Achievement Coordinator and further contact with home.

Outstanding achievements

Students who produce outstanding homework and show effort consistently with homework will be rewarded with stickers, comments in planners, postcards home and contact with parents.
