Dear Parents /Carers,

End of Year Examinations

As we move through the Summer Term all of our students are at an important stage of their education at Christ the King Catholic High School. Whilst our Year 11 students are working towards their final examinations, all other students are shortly to sit their end of year examinations; these will give us an opportunity to assess the progress your children have made during the school year. The date of these examinations are as follows:

Year 7 & Year 9	Monday 14 th May – Friday 25 th May
Year 8 & Year 10	Monday 4 th June - Friday 15 th June
Year 11	Monday 14 th May – Tuesday 19 th June
Each student has been given their individual timetable. Your child's Examination Timetable can be found on the school website.	

Your child will be given guidance by their subject teachers to help them with revision and preparations for these important examinations; please support your children by ensuring that they revise thoroughly at home. I would suggest that a minimum per day of 1 – 2 hours (Years 7 & 8) and 2 hours (Years 9 & 10) revision in the week/fortnight before and during the examination fortnight would be appropriate. Please try to provide your child with a quiet area to work and be mindful that phones and other electronic devices can be an unnecessary distraction during revision time.

It is vital that your child arrives on time for each examination and with the correct equipment. Please support us with this by ensuring that your child has black pens, pencils, a ruler, a rubber and a calculator. In Key Stage 4 each student will require a scientific calculator; not having this could affect your child's chances of success in their examinations. If providing the correct equipment is likely to cause a problem, please contact your child's Achievement Co-ordinator in advance of the examinations and they will be happy to help.

Uniform

Please be aware that from September girls choosing to wear trousers must have ones with the school logo on the front. These are available from our usual suppliers and full details of our uniform are available on the school website.
